ANNUAL SCHOLASTIC SCHOLARSHIP 2011 Application Criteria

The Cardinal Community Credit Union Annual Scholastic Scholarship Awards demonstrate the credit union's commitment to the future of Northeast Ohio. Eight (8) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to deserving high school seniors from our service area at the Annual Meeting, taking place on March 8, 2012.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CRITERIA:

1. Applicant or applicant's parents must be members of Cardinal Community Credit Union as of December 31, 2011.
2. Applicant must be a high school senior and have completed at least two (2) years at the school he or she is currently attending.
3. Applicant must have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or above.
4. Application must include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or school administrator. For example, a prospective engineer might use a recommendation from a math or science teacher.
5. The applicant must be applying to any accredited post-secondary educational program.
6. Disbursement of funds will be dependent upon verifiable acceptance in an accredited training institution.
7. If an awardee changes the educational goal after entering training, such change shall not be deemed cause for cancellation of the award, provided that the awardee continues education in the same or similar type of institution.
8. The applicant may supply whatever additional information he or she wishes in support of the application.
9. Decisions of the Committee will be final.
10. Failure to include the appropriate recommendations or to complete the application requirements will be cause for rejection of the application.
11. Scholarship winners will be invited to attend the Annual Meeting to receive their awards.
