## RULES FOR PORTFOLIO COMPETITION

All graduating seniors attending a high school or living in Lake and Geauga counties are eligible. Residence in the counties is not a requirement.

Students submitting a portfolio must plan to continue their study of art at an accredited college, university, or art school. Awards will be presented upon proof of enrollment. In case of ineligibility, the award will be presented to the next qualified participant.

Portfolios are an indication of a student's ability as an artist and should show competency in a variety of techniques with different media. Imagination and creativity in solving art-related problems also will be considered.

Enter this competition by completing the Competition Application and submitting a portfolio. No more than 12 examples of a student's work should be included. List the title, medium and size of each piece.

Pieces should not be larger than approximately 30 by 40 inches and placed in a commercial or sturdy homemade carrying case. Two-dimensional work should be neatly matted. Pieces need not be framed but should be protected. Photos or slides can be included for an extra-large or three-dimensional piece. Each piece should be labeled with the student's name, home address, phone number, and medium.

Portfolios may be submitted on a CD as .jpg images large enough to view detail of the work. A PowerPoint presentation (Windows) may also be included on the CD. The images' names should match those on the Competition Application and should include medium and size. The CD must be clearly labeled with the applicant's name, address, and phone number.

Portfolios should include a completed Competition Application placed within the carrying case (also known as a portfolio) or with the CD in an envelope of a size that accommodates both and protects the CD.

Arrangements have been made for portfolios or CD's to be dropped off at the Wildwood Cultural Center, 7645 Little Mountain Road, Mentor, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, April 16 through 12 noon Friday, April 20. CD's may be mailed or delivered to Stuart Abbey, 6430 Meldon Drive, Mentor, OH 44060 so that they arrive no later than Thursday, April 19. The winners, their families, and art teachers are invited to attend a reception and the CAA meeting Monday, April 23, at Wildwood Cultural Center, 7645 Little Mountain Road, Mentor.

Winners' portfolios will be displayed at the reception and CAA meeting. All other portfolios and CD's will be at Wildwood for the participants to pick up by Friday, April 27.
