RULES AND REGULATIONS

WILLOUGHBY JUNIOR WOMEN'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

1. The scholarship is to be known as the *Willoughby Junior Women's Club Scholarship*.
2. This scholarship is to be used for educational purposes beyond high school at any accredited college, university or technical school.
3. The scholarship is open to any high school senior, having a grade point average of 2.75 or higher, residing in the cities of Willoughby, Willoughby Hills, Waite Hill, Kirtland Hills and Kirtland.
4. There will be five \$2,000 scholarships awarded to five qualified students as selected by the scholarship committee of the Willoughby Junior Women's Club.
5. The award is to be applied to first year tuition charges, room and board, and lab or book fees for a full-time student. Payment will be made directly to the institution after certification of enrollment is received by the Treasure of the Willoughby Junior Women's Club. Funds will not be directly transferred to the student.
6. Should the recipient find that for some unforeseen reason he/she is unable to use the scholarship during the current year, he/she must forfeit his/her right to it.
7. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of volunteerism, community involvement, and evidence of responsibility and academic achievement of the student. Additional consideration will be given to children of active members of Willoughby Junior Women's Club.
8. The application will be held in strict confidence.
9. Applications may be obtained from the high school guidance offices or by contacting the Scholarship Chairman of the Willoughby Junior Women's Club.
10. Completed applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2012. Applications not postmarked by the said date shall not be considered. The completed application should be mailed to:

12. The applicant must submit two personal character references, one which must be from a faculty or school staff member. A family member may not submit personal character references.
